SAN FRANCISCO STAYS UNDER \$150

SOUTH OF MARKET › GOOD HOTEL

Living up to its do-good philosophy, this stucco hotel has platform beds made from reclaimed wood, wallpaper from recycled materials, and chandeliers from Voss glass water bottles. In the lobby, a vending machine sells wallets made from recycled FedEx packs. Mod cuckoo clocks and an old-school photo booth (*above*) keep the mood here fun. Nice bonuses are free loaner Globe bikes and use of the heated outdoor pool at sister property Americana (from \$99), across the street.

UNION SQUARE › HOTEL UNION SQUARE

A recent renovation left this 1913 hotel so up-to-date that a past denizen, *Maltese Falcon* author Dashiell Hammett, wouldn't recognize it—though he'd feel at home in the eponymous corner suite featuring a vintage typewriter and a window emblazoned with the book title *Spade and Archer*. Each room boasts high ceilings and details such as exposed brick, original molding, and tufted white-leather headboards. This prime property is right in the heart of Union Square shopping.
